LANDFILLS

The Ferland and McCord landfills are scheduled to close September 2024. The construction phase of the decommissioning process for the Ferland and McCord landfills is scheduled to begin September 2024. Once this phase has been completed, the landfills will be transitioned into transfer stations with bins. Helix Construction Ltd. has been awarded the contract for garbage removal. The



transfer stations will continue to operate with the same schedule. Every Wednesday of the month:

> Ferland - 9am-12pm McCord - 1pm-5pm

NEW THIS YEAR

R.M. 45 budgeted for the purchase of a 2023 150 AWD grader which was delivered in the spring to replace the 2011 140M. This year Council has also budgeted for the repair or replacement of multiple culverts and bridges. A contractor has been hired to complete these projects and should be completed this fall/winter.

R.M. 46 purchased a 2023 Riteway rockpicker to replace

the 2012 Schulte. It was delivered this spring and has been a great addition to the fleet! Council has also approved the removal and installation of damaged culverts throughout the R.M.

removing the header. It is for the safety of all road users that a pilot vehicle be utilized or remove the header off the equipment when transporting it.

SGI TRAFFIC SAFETY FUND GRANT

The Council for the R.M. of Mankota No. 45 passed a resolution early this year to apply for the SGI Traffic

Safety Fund Grant to purchase and install

4 Radar Feedback (RFD) signs for the Hamlets of Ferland and McCord. The R.M. was successful in obtaining this grant and the signs will be installed in late summer of this year.

Two signs will be installed along Highway 18 as you enter the Hamlet of Ferland limits, and the other two signs

will be installed in McCord as you enter Hamlet limits from the east and west.

- What are the location details?
- What are you burning?
- How long will your burn last?
- Your name and phone number.

You will be asked to call back once the burn has been completed.

Mankota Fire Department members will be notified once SPSA receives the call.
